Please note the Probate Estate Division Office, in the Historic Courthouse Building at 84 Broad, is temporarily relocating to the Blake Tenement Building at 10 Court House Square, Third Floor, Charleston, SC 29401. Commitment, Adult Guardianship and Conservatorship, and Marriage Divisions remain in Suite 469 of 100 Broad Street, Charleston, SC 29401.

Due to the construction at the Historic Courthouse, the staff in the Historic Courthouse will be working at the Blake Tenement Building. We will have Estate staff on the third floor of the Blake Tenement Building to answer questions and help with estate administration. You will be individually notified of any specific change to your proceeding.
